

Nominate deserving FEMALE Grade 12 students to join the 2024 STEM MentHER programme

School Principals and Educators, you are invited to nominate your deserving Grade 12 female students to join the STEM MentHER 2024 programme.

This dynamic year-long mentorship programme guides and streamlines deserving Grade 12 female students into the STEM fields of study: Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics.

Successful candidates are mentored by female academics and postgraduate students. They gain access to tailormade programmes aimed at grade 12 students. They also become role models for other girls.

Venues

The STEM MentHER programme currently runs at the following universities:

- University of Johannesburg
- University of the Witwatersrand
- University of Cape Town
- Stellenbosch University
- University of KwaZulu-Natal

Nominees can only join one cohort – at the closest university to their school. They must be able to travel at their own cost to that university campus for in-person sessions during holidays. All other sessions are online, with costs covered by STEM MentHER.

How to nominate candidates

- Please complete and submit our online form. To do so, you will need to upload:
 - your nominee's final Grade 11 academic results
 - a brief motivation letter (not exceeding 900 words) that explains your nominee's aspirations and why she should be admitted to the programme. The letter must be on your school letterhead and/or stamped with an official school stamp.
- Only Principals and Educators may submit nominations, and the nominee must be a Grade 12 female student who attends your school.
- More than one student at your school may be nominated.
- Nominations close on 6 March and successful candidates will be announced publicly on 12 March 2024.
